“This blend of 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Merlot, 12% Cabernet Franc, 5% Petit Verdot and 3% Malbec exhibits a deep purplish ruby color and seductive, perfumed aromas of blackberries, blueberries, cherries, crushed roses, lavender, cigar box and violets. The dark fruit flavors are deep and penetrating, marked by licorice, bittersweet chocolate, French roast and loess minerals. On the back, the wine turns thick textured, with sensations of macerated berries, roasted walnuts, mocha, toffee and graphite and moderate oak (50% new French), followed by a lingering, slightly grainy ripe tannin finish” – Rand Sealey
