"Pale, light yellow. A bit deeper-pitched but more serious on the nose than the basic Sémillon, offering notes of ripe stone fruits, lanolin and honey, plus a touch of spices. Plush, broad and even a bit glycerol, but with harmonious acidity and a light phenolic element giving the wine chewiness and grip. Boasts serious palate presence already but I'd wait a year for this wine to loosen up a bit. Quite firm on the finish today, and considerably more concentrated and long than the regular Sémillon. A very promising, very dry Washington Sémillon, and one to follow." – Stephen Tanzer

"Brilliant straw-gold colored, this 100% varietal white possesses fresh aromas of pear, honeydew melon and citrus with scents of apple blossoms, alpine flowers and wet stone. The flavors are vivid and refreshingly balanced, with notes of grape and pear skins, melon rind and Frenchman Hills alluvial minerals. The nicely textured back picks up touches of beeswax and butternut, counterpointed by Meyer lemon, on the way to a crisp finish. Excellent value." – Rand Sealey
