*"Pale, bright straw-yellow. Aromas of orange zest, ripe peach and clove, with an element of lemony lift. Slightly glyceric but not at all heavy, thanks to harmonious lemony acidity. Quite dry and a bit youthfully aggressive in the early going but nicely delineated for its octane level and brisk and persistent on the back end. This, too, shows a positive phenolic dustiness on the finish, as well as a lighter touch than the Stillwater Creek Sémillon."* – Stephen Tanzer
