Quite dry and a bit youthfully aggressive in the early going but nicely delineated for its octane level and brisk and persistent on the back end. This, too, shows a positive phenolic dustiness on the finish, as well as a lighter touch than the Stillwater Creek Sémillon."* – Stephen Tanzer
