This 60% / 40% combination exhibits a deep purplish-crimson color and seductive aromas of blackberry, cherry, plum and cassis with scents of crushed roses, mulberry, cigar box, sandalwood and incense. The flavors mirror the aromatics with ample, yet focused, dark fruits that are endowed with licorice, dark chocolate, French roast and Red Mountain scorched earth. The penetration continues on the back with macerated berries, roasted walnuts, mocha, touches of leather and grilled meats, and graphite, followed by a lingering sweet-dry tannin finish.” – Rand Sealey
