*"The 2018 'Luminesce' is a compelling blend of 55% Sauvignon Blanc with the remainder Semillon which was sourced from the esteemed Seven Hills Vineyard in the Walla Walla Valley AVA. On the nose this takes on bright Bosc pear and shades of kumquat rind that mingle with the baking spices undertones. The freshness and texture imparted is lovely, as lively acidity and a faint salinity runs through the core of the wine. Bright melon and lemon curd flavors collide with the copious minerals.
