*“Brooding aromas of blackberry, cassis, licorice and violet, with Cabernet pyrazine notes of pepper and herbs nicely countered by minerality. Plush and sweet but slightly inky on the palate, offering mouthfilling flavors of black fruits and licorice. Finishes with big, granular, tongue-clenching tannins that avoid dryness but still come off as more rustic and energetically extracted than those of the 2016 Ferguson Red Wine bottling. Still needs time for the tannins to evolve but will they ever come into harmony with the wine's fruit? (this wine was bottled in July of 2016 but was only released in March of this year as a wine club item)” – Stephen Tanzer*
