Brilliant copper-tinged pink colored, this 100% Grenache Rosé possesses fresh, floral aromas of strawberry, pomegranate, guava and tangerine, with scents of rose petals, orange blossoms, pink lavender and pink incense.

The flavors are fresh and bright, with notes of grape skin, tangerine peel and Alder Ridge minerals. The back picks up fraise liqueur and pomegranate seeds, followed by a crisp, nicely juiced dry finish.

This pale colored Grenache Rose was sourced from the Horse Heaven Hills AVA. Fresh and vibrant with a great combination of tension and viscosity, this reveals pretty rose water and watermelon flavors with shades of cantaloupe and sourdough bread on the palate. Seriously good now, enjoy this beautiful bottling over the next several years. Drink 2020-2025.

From a vast south-facing vineyard overlooking the Columbia River, this luscious pink captures the sunny disposition of the place, with cherry-strawberry scents that give way to broadly pink fruit flavors. A tart phenolic line cuts into all the richness and provides the grip for lamb kebabs.

Pale peach in color, with aromas of watermelon, strawberry and herb, followed by broad feeling, just a hair off-dry drinking flavors that lead to a warm finish. The flavors are lovely but get a bit bogged down by the ripeness, without the acidity to entirely balance it out.
