### 2019 Luminesce Estate Seven Hills Vineyard Walla Walla Valley

#### 92 PTS - EDITORS' CHOICE, TOP 100 ENTHUSIAST WINES FOR 2020

This wine is equally split between the two varieties. Pleasing aromas of pear, citrus, fig, mineral and herb are followed by rounded, textured flavors that lead to a warm finish. The acidity is heightened compared to recent vintages, making the flavors snap. Give it a few years in the cellar to see it at its best.

#### 90 PTS

*Vinous, Stephen Tanzer* - December 2020

Pale, bright yellow. Attractive floral lift to the aromas of orange blossom, white peach, passion fruit and brown spices. Enters the mouth firm and nicely dry; then less soft and silky in the mid-palate than the two Sémillons in the early going, with more held back in reserve. Shows more lemony citricity without going austere. Today the Sauvignon Blanc cut dominates but I suspect this wine will be more harmonious next summer. Still, I don't find quite the tension of the 2018 bottling. Nicely tactile on the aftertaste.

Sleek and nicely textured, with supple lemon verbena, apple peel and honeysuckle accents. Semillon and Sauvignon Blanc. Drink now.
