This 50% Sauvignon Blanc, 50% Semillon combination offers a brilliant straw-gold color and attractive aromas of pear-apple, peach, Crenshaw melon, Key lime and a hint of papaya, with scents of apple blossoms, honeysuckle, jasmine and white incense. The flavors are bright and vivid, combining the crispness of the Sauvignon Blanc with the creamy, slightly tropical texture of the Semillon. On the back, the wine builds up into a persistently mineral finish.

This wine is equally split between the two varieties. Pleasing aromas of pear, citrus, fig, mineral and herb are followed by rounded, textured flavors that lead to a warm finish. The acidity is heightened compared to recent vintages, making the flavors snap. Give it a few years in the cellar to see it at its best.
