2022 Chenin Blanc 'Old Vines' Yakima Valley

Aromas of apricots and lemon pith, together with floral fragrance of lily-of-the-valley, elderflower and crushed stones. Some raw almond, too. So steady and focused on the palate with crisp, pointy acidity and fresh citrusy character. Bright and mineral with some flinty hints at the end. Drink now.

This is a true Washington wine classic that is also a spectacular value. Gravenstein apple and lemon verbena aromas swirl about your head as notes of river stones and white pepper try to sneak up on you. There's some body here, with a rich texture and flavors like grilled lemons, Bosc pears and a lemon granita.

Elderflower, wet slate, and lemon zest announce this old vine Chenin Blanc crafted from vineyards planted in the 1970s, the oldest in Washington state for Chenin. The palate is refreshing and crisp. Lean citrus flavours of lime, lemon and grapefruit are backed by stony mineral components and a kiss of white pepper to finish.
