## 2021 Syrah Columbia Valley

The 2021 Syrah is dark and enticing, with earth tones, crushed blackberries, crushed stones and spiced citrus. This is silky-smooth, energized by juicy acidity, as ripe wild berries cascade across a core of tactile minerals and savory spice. The 2021 finishes grippy and long, leaving a tart fruit concentration to resonate over a layer of edgy tannins. For an entry-level Syrah, this is some pretty serious stuff.

Attractive black pepper and black fruit aromas waft from the glass. Crushed rock and tea leaves, too. It's full-bodied, supple and creamy, with ripe tannins and a caressing finish. 82% Syrah, 16% Grenache and 2% Mourvèdre. Drink or hold.
