This wine was fermented and aged in French oak (35% new) with partial malolactic fermentation (60%). The aromas are pleasingly nuanced, with notes of apple, caramel, and a kiss of spice. An exceptionally well-proportioned, lightly textured, medium-bodied palate follows, full of stone fruit flavors. Clarified butter notes accent the finish. Class and sophistication, this wine brings both in abundance.
