Evergreen Vineyard · Columbia Valley

*“(from windblown loess and caliche with basalt close to the surface): Pale, bright golden-yellow. Pungent nectarine and spice and spice aromas are complicated by a touch of crushed stone. Tightly wound and uncompromising, showing less texture than the basic Columbia Valley Chardonnay. Higher in acidity too, and quite dry, this rather stark wine will probably age longer. A sommelier's delight.”*

The back reveals sensations of poire William liqueur, lemon custard, and bright fruit acids lifting the lightly spiced finish.”* – Rand Sealey
